
X-Repair Placement for Rotator Cuff Repair Augmentation







Select X-Repair size corresponding to the tear size and the length between the medial suture position and the lateral anchors. Orient X-Repair's bone LENGTH (welded end to welded end) along the medial-to-lateral direction of the tendon.



Place sutures for attaching X-Repair to the tendon medial to the rotator cuff repair sutures.



Complete rotator cuff repair.



Use anchors dedicated to X-Repair lateral to the tendon repair, or suture anchors for rotator cuff repair with additional sutures.



- Attach X-Repair to the tendon using the medially placed sutures, and then laterally to bone via the suture anchors. Place sutures through the X-Repair internal to the ends of the device (>5 mm bite size).
- Impose appropriate tension on X-Repair to establish load sharing.
